

**Pathway from Graduate Diploma to M.Ed.**

Assumption University and the Faculty of Education at the University of Windsor have recently signed a Memorandum of Agreement. The agreement provides a pathway from Assumption's Graduate Diploma in Catholic Studies to a Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree at the University of Windsor.

Students with Assumption University's Graduate Diploma in Catholic Studies course work completed within five years with a minimum grade of 70% may be granted credit for up to two graduate term courses completed before their application to the Master of Education (M.Ed.) program.

The Graduate Diploma in Catholic Studies is considered a **hiring asset** by eight Catholic school boards in Ontario, including the Windsor-Essex District Catholic School Board.
